

# Disneyland Resort's Fairy Tale Weddings: Fact Sheet

A past bride had each of Disney's Snow White's Seven Dwarfs carry the train of her dress down the aisle

One bride wore a Mickey Mouse shaped wedding ring (a solitaire with two smaller diamonds as Mickey ears)

Approximately one in four brides ride in Cinderella's horse-drawn Coach

The most popular spot to pop the question: Sleeping Beauty Castle

The most popular wedding theme: Cinderella

There are approximately 300 weddings at the Disneyland Resort each year

The most requested wedding months: May, June, October and November

Average number of guests at a reception: 138

Current trends:

- Sweetheart table vs. head table
- Mom & Dad both walking the bride down the aisle
- Vow Renewals
- "Familymoons" and destination weddings

Craziest Wedding: Gothic bride adorned in a black wedding gown, black hair, pale skin and dark make-up

Newest place to host a reception at the Disneyland Resort: Right inside Disney's California Adventure park
